What is a DNA fingerprint?

A DNA fingerprint is a unique combination of genetic variation at specific locations in the genome known as DNA markers



It is unique to an individual



It is a combination of the genetic variation inherited from the individual's parents

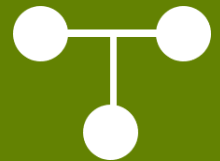
What does the process of DNA fingerprinting entail?



1. Establish a consensus DNA reference fingerprint



2. Use this for clonal verification or parentage analysis
